

# Generating a long term report

This fact sheet will help you to generate a Long Term Trial Report. These reports are generally better for making decisions about which variety to grow because they are the combination of several years of trialling, rather than just a single year.

1 Click on **Search Variety Performance**.

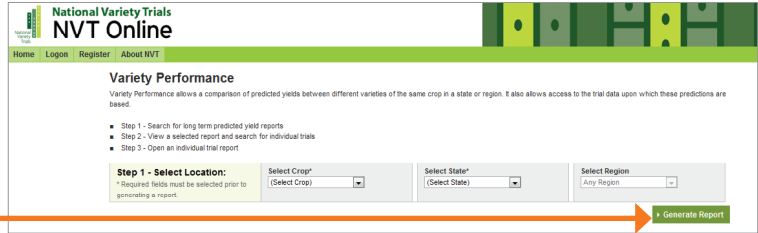
3 Click on the drop-down arrow to:

- select a **Crop** from the list
- select a **State** from the list
- select a **Region** from the list.

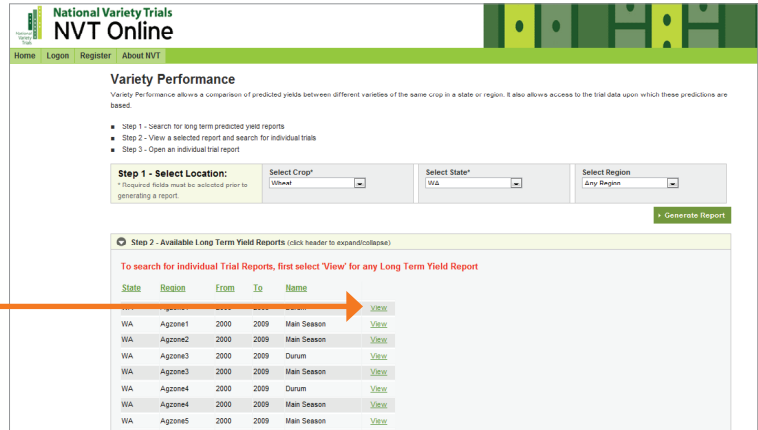
