

Using Google maps on NVT online

This fact sheet will help you to use Google Maps on the National Variety Trials website. There are many functions that are available with the Google Maps platform which means that there is a lot of information that can be accessed with only a few clicks of your mouse. To use Google Maps on NVT Online, go to www.nvtonline.com.au

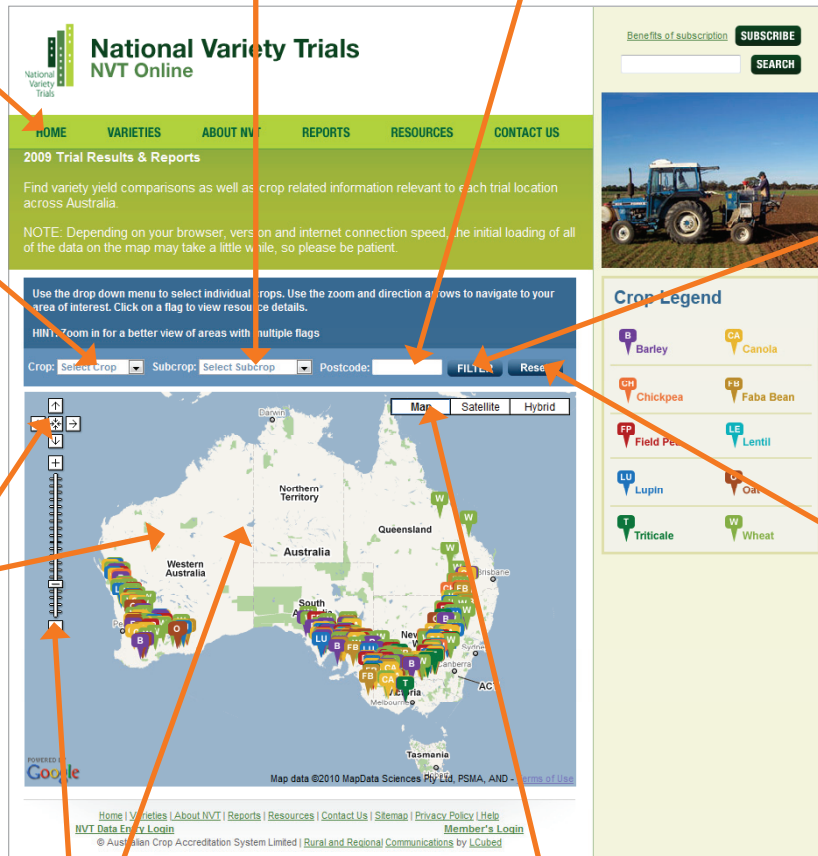
After selecting which crop you want to view, you may like to **narrow your filter further**. Chickpeas for example can be filtered to desi or kabuli types.

Enter your **postcode** to show trials on the map in your area.

Click the **Home** button to take you back to the front page of NVT Online.

Select a crop from the list and click filter to narrow down your search to a particular crop type.

Navigate around the map by either using the buttons in the corner or by clicking and dragging on any area of the map.



After selecting either crop type, subcrop or postcode, the filter button will **run your filter**.

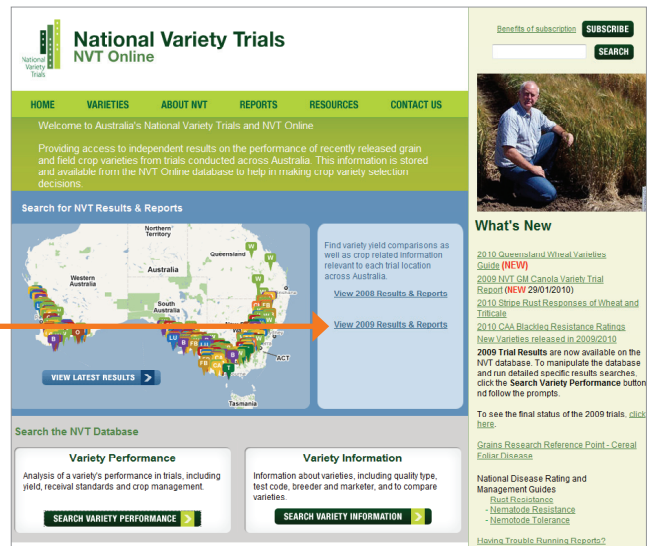
Reset button takes you back to the start if you would like to change filters or just start again.

Zoom the map in and out by either using the sliding tab on the left hand side or by using your mouse wheel if it has that capability.

Select which map you want to view from either a regular map or a satellite image or a hybrid of the two.

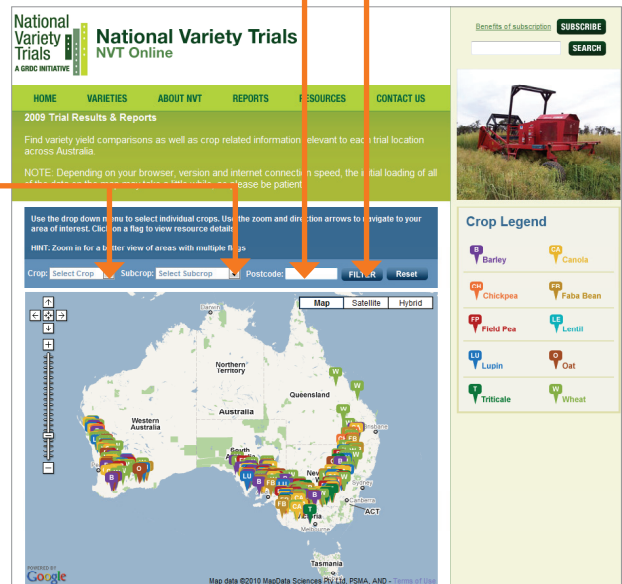
Click on a **year** that you would like to view the results from.

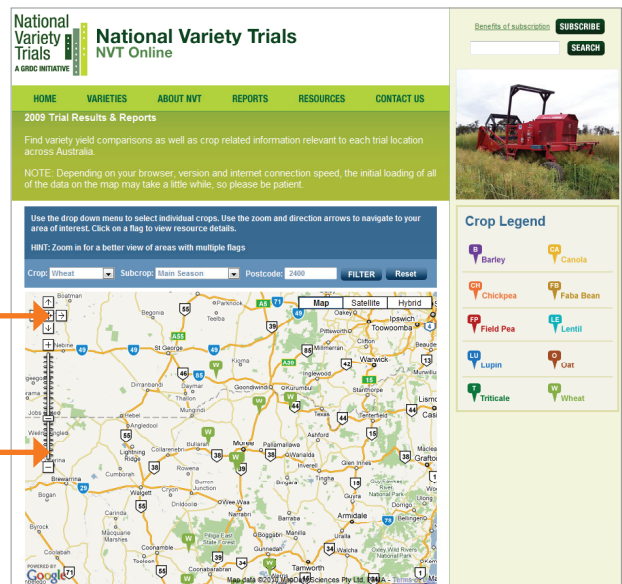
To see all crop trials near you, enter your **postcode** into the box and click on **filter**.

To refine the search to a particular **crop** and **subcrop**, select from the list by clicking on the dropdown arrows.



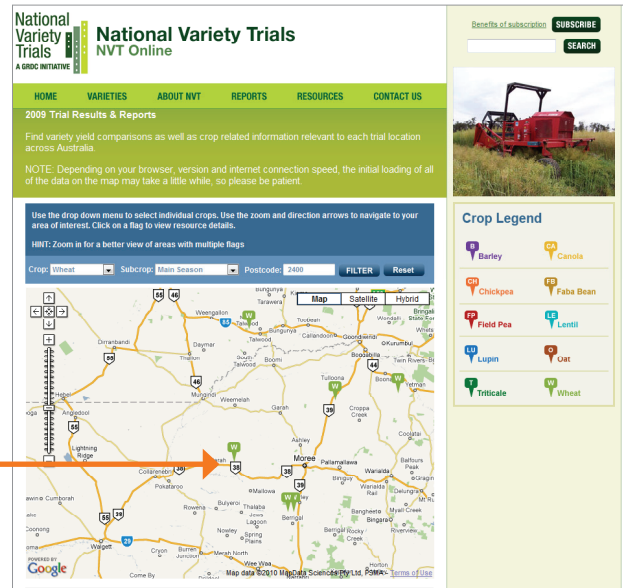

Use the **direction arrows** and the **zoom** bar to navigate around the map.



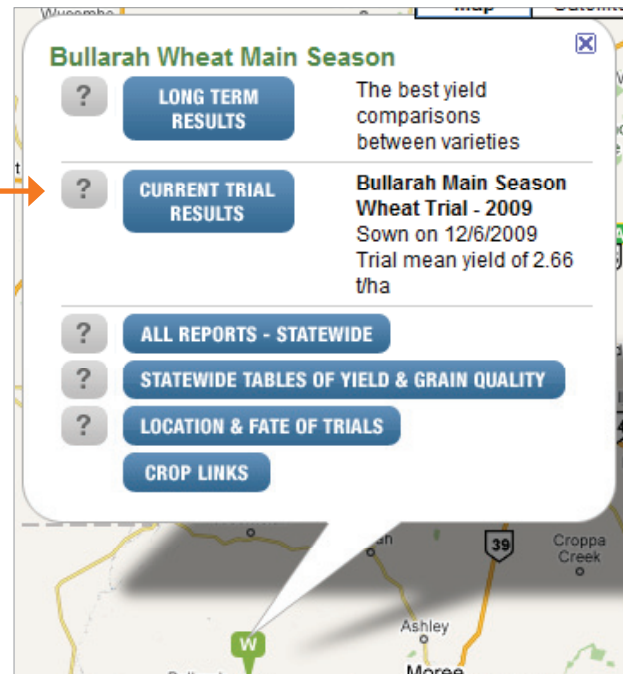

Click on the **icon** for the trial you would like to read more about. A **bubble** will appear with all information relating to that trial.
